You Can Help the Porters on Kilimanjaro

Deeper Africa is working with the Kilimanjaro Porters Assistance Project to improve the working conditions of porters on Mount Kilimanjaro. You have an opportunity to help with this effort on your upcoming trip to Tanzania. Please consider taking some donated clothing as part of your airline baggage allowance. There will be no airline or customs fees.

The Kilimanjaro Porters Assistance Project (KPAP) is an initiative of the International Mountain Explorers Connection (IMEC), a nonprofit organization based in Boulder, CO. KPAP aims to reduce the occurrence of hypothermia, frostbite, or worse, among ill-prepared porters by lending donated clothing at no charge for the porter's use while working on Kilimanjaro.

IMEC will ship you as much or as little clothing as you wish to carry (we can also supply a duffel bag). You will be asked to cover the shipping charges as a tax deductible donation. Typical cost is \$1 per pound. If you live in the Boulder/Denver area, the clothes will be delivered to you. This clothing will be part of your checked airline baggage (2 X 50lbs no-cost limit). KPAP organizes the pick up of the clothing once you are in Tanzania.
